


Carnation Lollipop Flower



Carnations come in many different colors, including: pink, light red, dark red, white, green, purple, yellow, and striped. Carnation leaves are narrow and stalk less, and their color varies from green to grey-blue or purple. Carnations grow big, full blooms on strong, straight stems.

You will need:

Colorful paper 6 paper cupcake baking cups Non-toxic glue Scissors and help from an adult Lollipop with wrapper

Instructions to make the flower:

- · Poke a hole in the middle of one of the paper cupcake baking cups for the lollipop stick to fit through, and push the cup to the top of the lollipop.
- · Squish the paper cup around the lollipop with your hand.
- · Repeat steps 1 and 2 with each of the 5 remaining cupcake baking cups.

Instructions to make the leaf:

- Fold a piece of paper in half in the color you are using for the leaf.
- · Line up the folded edge of your paper with the stem side of the leaf pattern and trace it. · With the paper still folded in half, cut out the leaf shape.
- · Unfold the leaf and put some nontoxic glue on the middle part that looks like a stem.
- · Glue the leaf around the stick of the lollipop close enough to the flower that the leaf can hold the blossom up.
- · Glue the 2 sides of the leaf shape together using nontoxic glue.
