



MAKE AN OTTER HOLLOWFACE

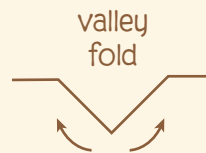
Fold this otter to create an amazing optical illusion!

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Otter hollowface printout
- Scissors
- Tape or glue

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut out the otter and base. Carefully cut the dotted lines along the otter's body, mane and face.
2. Now, practice making the 2 types of folds used in this project: mountain and valley folds.



Mountain Fold: Folding the paper down to create a peak, looks like the letter A.

Valley Fold: Folding the paper up to create an indentation, looks like the letter V.

3. Starting at the otter's head, find the line above the eyes. Fold along this line, creating a valley fold.
4. Find the line at the top of the otter's head near the ear and make a valley fold. The yellow star should now be pointing right.
5. Attach this tab with tape behind the otter's head.
6. Now you're ready to fold the base so the otter can stand up. Find the solid lines along the otter's body and in the ice. Fold the side flaps in towards the back of the horse in a mountain fold and fold in the B and C tabs.
7. Then, fold up the bottom flap along with the D tab.
8. The flaps and tabs should fit together forming a base that allows the polar bear to stand up. Affix the E and F tabs to the flaps with tape or glue.
9. You're all done! Place the otter on a flat surface and observe the cool hollow face illusion!
